Fasina assumes office, vows to reposition FUOYE globally

he 4th Vice Chancellor of the Federal University Oye Ekiti, Prof Abayomi Sunday Fasina has taken over the mantle of leadership at the university.

The inauguration took place on Thursday, February 11,2021 at the entrance of the University Main Administrative block.

Speaking after the handing over, the new chancellor, Professor Abayomi Sunday Fasina pledged to initiate an aggressive process of dialogue and reconciliation with all aggrieved parties in the institution, stressing that, "we need everybody on board to build the FUOYE of our dream."

He also promised to put in place immediately an Internally Generated Revenue (IGR), mechanism and conduct an academic retreat/summit to reposition FUOYE globally.

"We will try and create wealth for the university through what I called Risk to Wealth Initiatives."


