Professor Fasina made this disclosure during his courtesy visit to the Deputy Governor of Ekiti State, Otunba Bisi Egbeyemi in his office at Ado Ekiti on Thursday, February 25, 2021.

The FUOYE Vice

Chancellor, who is a Professor of Soil Science, reiterated his desire to facilitate meaningful growth in the area of food production and security saying that Ekiti state has all the potentials to be self sufficient in food production which should lead to wealth creation.

"I expect a situation where travelers going to Abuja and the rest of the North through our corridor from Ifaki, Ayegbaju, Oye Ekiti, Itapa, Ikole etc will stop by to shop for high quality university farm products like garri, palm oil, vegetables, tomatoes,

honey, bread, table water and so on", he said recalling that he had done similar things in the state.

"Sir, I was part of the Technical Consultants that worked for the establishment of Ekiti State College of Agriculture, at Isan Ekiti. That School is there now contributing to excellence in Ekiti State".

Also, I participated in the formation of Afe Babalola University (ABUAD) farm. Together with others, we planned that agro commodities of the farm should be processed for consumers. Again it is there now. We now have ABUAD garri, ABUAD mango juice, ABUAD palm oil etc.

At Ekiti State University, I started the Faculty of Agriculture and today that faculty is doing well. Why not in FUOYE?

"I want to appreciate the support of Governor of Ekiti State, Dr. Kayode Fayemi in the area of provision of infrastructure for the University and urged him to support the institution more in the areas of hostel, hall and other necessary facilities" Prof Fasina said.

He's always in my office to discuss how the university should be crisis free. I can trust him" he further said.

FUOYE Staff school coming, says VC

The Federal University Oye Ekiti (FUOYE) is set to commence staff school at Ayegbaju.

The Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Abayomi Sunday Fasina made this disclosure on Day 2 of his tour of faculties to Faculties of Education, Arts and Law.

Speaking to Dean's and Professors at the faculty of Education, Prof. Fasina charged the Educationists to come up with proposals for the establishment of the staff school.

He also charged them to come up with plans for the establishment of Part Time programme saying the university expects much from the faculty.

At the faculty of Arts, the Vice-Chancellor expressed satisfaction with the Faculty generally and for producing three (3) Post Doctoral Fellowships in particular saying, "I don't think any other faculty has achieved what you have achieved".

Promising them a new faculty building, Prof. Fasina observed that several other faculties established after Faculty of Arts already have faculty buildings.

"You need to clap for yourself

that you are about to graduate PhD students and M.Phil students. For doings so well in Post Graduate School, I want to congratulate you, I want to also commend you" he further said.

Earlier the Dean of the Faculty, Prof. Tajudeen Bolanle Opoola had listed his achievements to include functional deep well, and pumping machine, full NUC accreditation for Linguistics and Languages programme as well as History and International studies programme.

Furthermore, students of Theatre and Media Arts came third at Ogun state Government Drum Festival and were awarded #500,000 cash prize. The Faculty also hosted The Society of Nigeria Theatrical Artists (SONTA) 31st annual convention and International Conference.

The Dean further explained that the faculty published a Faculty Journal called "The Oye Journal of Arts Vol. 1 and 2 with ISSN 2705-3881. He presented two copies to the Vice-Chancellor as souvenirs.

Also the Department of Theatre and Media Arts published a departmental journal (ALARINJO) ISSN 2638-7238, volumes 1,2,3,4 and 5. Copies were also presented to the Vice-Chancellor.

Another publication according to Prof. Opoola is Festschrift in honour of Prof. Mathew Abiodun, the pioneer Head, Linguistics and Languages Department ISBN, 778-978-980-583-9 and Oye Journal of Literature and Popular Culture, Vol. 1, No. 1.

Still counting, the Dean listed the establishment of Departments of Philosophy and Religion studies and cited three scholars, Dr. (Mrs) Gbadegesin, Dr. Paul Onanuga and Dr. Adeoye who just completed post doctoral fellowships at South Africa, Germany and UK respectively.

Prof. Opoola further disclosed the establishment of Digital Language laboratory where over 59 million e-books are accessible.

Prof. Bakare Ojo Rasaki is a member of the faculty and currently Honourable Commissioner for Arts, Culture and Tourism in Ekiti State Government expressed joy that Prof. Fasina emerged as Vice-Chancellor.

While congratulating Prof. Fasina, the Commissioner joined the Dean to request for a befitting Faculty of Arts building complex.
