

he Non Academic Staff Union Cooperative Society of the Federal University Oye-Ekiti (FUOYE-NASU) at her 5th and 6th combined Annual General Meeting (AGM) held at the university Auditorium on Thursday May 20,2021 announced a net operating profit of N7,410,535 despite COVID 19 pandemic.

The revision of appointments will cover all those done between Saturday August 1, 2021 and Wednesday February 10, 2021.


