

**GST108/GST110 Government, Society and Economy/African Culture and Civilisation
(2+0+0 2 Units)**

- This course looks at the evolution of state as a political unit and the role of individual in the development of a state (the organization and structure of government, evolution of the state, political philosophy),
- socio-political economy of the society (system of government, the rule of law, resources and resource system, social mobility and social change),
- the influence of government in the management of the society (environment and culture, social stratification)
 - **GST110 African Culture and Civilisation**
 - This course covers the study of African cultural history and characteristics, arts in pre-colonial times.
 - It also at the evolution of Africa as a political unit; phenomenon of indigene/settlers and its conflicting outcome as well as traditional concept of trade, social justice, individual and national development.
 - Moreover, peculiar norms and values, national attitudes and conducts (cult activities and related vices), reorientation, moral obligations of citizens, national values and environmental problems will be discussed.
 - Particular attention will be on Nigerian local cases.
